Dear Members of the Alton-Barnstead Half Moon Lake Association,

Safety on the lake is of the utmost importance to all the membership. Please observe the local rule of traveling in a counter-clockwise direction around the lake. Over the years this rule has saved many accidents from happening. In addition, you must comply with all the safe boating laws of the State of New Hampshire. If you fail to do so you will be subject to stiff fines from the Department of Safety Services. This lake is patrolled by a Safety Warden. If you have any questions about safe boating, or even wish to file a complaint about unsafe boating practices, you may call the New Hampshire Department of Safety Services for Boating 603-293-2037 or 603-271-3336. If you wish to pick up a booklet on the Boating Laws for the State of New Hampshire, please call our Association Treasurer - Frank Brewster - 776-5490.

Is your dock and/or raft registered with the State of New Hampshire? It is in your best interest to apply for and get permission for them to be on the lake. Call 603-271-2147.

If there are certain lake activities you would like to see the Association sponsor, bring your ideas and suggestions to the annual meeting so they can be discussed.

Lastly, please help to keep our lake water clean! Do not deposit any form of trash or sewage into the lake. It is also against the law to wash up with soap in the lake.
