If you haven't been there before, drive north on Route 28 and take the road on the right indicated by signs to Camp Mi Te Na and Fern Hill. Take the second right which is Hollywood Beach Road, and then the first right which is Rustic Shores Road and has a sign listing the names of those who have cottages there. The road is a steep cliff road and the Holt's cottage is on the left near the end, right on the beach. Our cars will be parked all around it. You could also come across the lake by boat.

George Fitzpatrick will have the latest water testing report and we can discuss ways to continue to keep our lake clean and safe. Bring any concerns you may have to the meeting so they can be discussed.

Don't forget the counterclockwise direction for all boats traveling on the lake, the ban on jet skis on weekends, and the necessity of removing all vegetation from your boat, motor, and trailer before launching into Half Moon if you've had your boat in another lake, because we don't want Milfoil and other aquatic nuisances in our lake.
