Fortunately the selectman saw it our way and voted to deny the request. As a result, they are still in place.

Just another reminder that we have plenty of T-shirts available that we purchased last year. I will have the various designs and sizes set out on a separate table during the meeting. Kids sizes are \$8.00 and adults are \$10.00.

Our lake water testing volunteers will continue to monitor the lake and discuss the results at our meetings.

Please remember the counter-clockwise direction on the lake for all boat traffic. Also, please remember that the cove can get pretty crazy, especially on weekends so please stay alert and be safe at all times.

Boating certificates are required this year for people 43 years old and younger (born on or after Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 1963). This site also gives you access to the official NH state boating law that requires this certificate.

Dues are now \$10.00 per year, per household and are payable at the meeting. You may also mail them using the form below. As will recall, we voted to raise the dues from \$5.00 per year to \$10.00 per year at last year's August meeting.
