Treasury balance in the Pittsfield-Concord Savings Bank is \$1,128.05. Dues for this year will be \$1.00 per property owner.

The Association is sponsoring a project this year on fire protection and ambulance service. If you called in an emergency, could they find your cottage quickly? Experience has taught us that the chances are not good.

We want to provide the towns of Action and Barnstead with a map showing the shortest route to your cottage. This may mean that the roads around the Lake must be identified by name or number.

You can help yourself by providing a prominent nameplate at your cottage. Fire truck pumpers must be able to drive close to the water (50 - 60 feet) so be prepared to tell them the closest accessibility to water.

Your representative will contact you for your vote on the proposal made to present the boys camp and girls camp with \$10.00 each to increase their next year's fireworks display. It was felt that the majority of the Lake families benefit from this show, and a contribution would increase its length.

Your Association wants to remind you that the boat launching ramp next to the dam and culvert on the North Barnstead Road has better access to the water than the public beach on Rte. 28.

If your representative missed you and you found this NEWSLETTER in your door, will you please drop over and see him. It is a short summer, and he wants as much time to enjoy it as you do -- so how about saving him another trip!

Please take care of your litter, especially beer bottles out on the Lake. The bottles drift ashore and break on the beach where people can suffer serious injury.
