SECOND NEWSLETTER -- SUMMER 1970

Our second meeting of 1970 was held August 23rd at Treasurer Frank Brewster's Camp with twenty two members, Officers and Area Representatives in attendance.

It was voted that our By-Laws be amended noting that expenditures of over \$100.00 be presented in written form so that the Area Representatives could present these to their members for signed approval or disapproval, with the only variation being that as originally stated in the By-Laws, the Officers having voting rights in emergencies.

As previously noted, the boat ramp was further discussed as to hard topping, and three bids were presented by Frank Brewster. Since there was mixed feeling, and the amendment had been made as to expenditures over \$100.00, it was agreed to keep the boat ramp as is with grading as needed, with possible hard topping to be voted on next year.

The issue of improper drainage into the Lake, whether it be sewerage or other pollutants when encountered, Officers of our Association shall request correction before any other action is taken. In our next Newsletter we shall offer solutions to drainage problems.

Mr. Dick Headley is checking with Attorney Gallagher as to retaining him on a yearly basis. Mr. Gallagher has been very helpful in the past and has done an excellent job of protecting the Girl's camp from encroachment on their rights.

Officers for the next 3 years will be elected at the first meeting in July 1971.
