The next regular meetings of this Association will be held on Sunday, July 13, 1980 and Sunday, August 24, 1980, each meeting to start at 10:00 A.M. at Frank Brewster's cottage situated next to Mi Te Na Boy's Camp. Area Representatives are urged to attend so that the residents in their area will be properly represented. All other residents are welcome to attend to present any problems they may have in person.

All Area Reps are requested to obtain an up-to-date list of winter addresses and phone numbers of the people in their area and either give it to John Alliegro prior to the July 13th meeting or submit it at that meeting. The cooperation of the Reps are vital in this instance so that a new list of winter addresses and phone numbers of all residents may be compiled and made available to the Police and Fire Depts., should it be necessary to contact any of the summer residents in an emergency during the off-season.

During the last year this Association had the boat ramp next to Herndon's paved, sponsored and financed the water ski show, organized and provided the flares for the boat parade and contributed toward the purchase of fire works by the Mi Te Na Boy's Camp.

All of these activities were costly and put a drain on our treasury. It was, therefore, voted at the last meeting of this Association held on August 26, 1979 to raise the annual dues to \$2.00 per household.

The Area Reps are urged to collect the \$2.00 dues from each member-family in his area and to enlist those families that are not already members.

This Association is dedicated to the service of all residents on or near Halfmoon Lake and can only perform the necessary services if it is given the financial support of all residents and the cooperation of the Area Reps.
