

ALTON-BARNSTEAD HALF MOON LAKE ASSOCIATION SECRETARY'S REPORT

July 14, 1991

The July 14th, 1991 meeting of the Alton-Barnstead Half Moon Lake Association was called to order at 11:05 a.m. The meeting was held at Larry Holt's cottage on Rustic Shores.

The Secretary's Report was read and accepted.

The Treasurer's Report stating a balance of \$2955.04 was accepted.

Report was made that the water in our lake was tested on June 12th and again on July 2nd and we were awaiting the results from the State of New Hampshire.

John Chilicki has spoken to Kent Locke and he was receptive to posting a sign at the boat ramp and a letter requesting permission will be sent by the association.

George Fitzpatrick reported that new boards were placed in the dam and it has been adjusted to maintain the level it was previously set at. The lake level is down because of the problem that existed in April and early May.

The Marine Patrol will be notified in reference to a new mooring at Dalton Beach and also about new markers and the correct placement of others.
