The Contract was awarded to the New Hampshire Concrete Corp. and construction was completed just as the snow began to fly in the first storm of the year. In order to complete this major project a unified front was needed and received, for this we express our sincere thanks. Our answer to an interlake connector is now cast in concrete.

Participation in this project has been excellent for the short time we had to collect funds before the end of the season.

Of the 117 Lake property owner prospects 94 pledged financial support:
94 of 117 = 80%

Seventy three (73) of the 94 have paid their pledges to date.
73 of 94 = 78%
